In addition to the United States, the F-35 is marketed and sold to several other countries, including Australia, Japan, Norway, the United Kingdom, and Canada. The first flight of a fully assembled F-35 took place on March 12, 2007, after years of delays, cost overruns and production problems. The first operational fighter was delivered to the U.S. Air Force, operating as the 79th Fighter Squadron, on December 21, 2015, at Hill Air Force Base.<sup>[3]</sup><sup>[4]</sup><sup>[5]</sup> The first production F-35A for the U.S. Air Force is a unit of the United States Marine Corps, operating as the VMFA-314 from Marine Corps Air Station Yuma.<sup>[6]</sup> The first operational F-35B is a U.S. Navy unit, operating from Naval Air Station Patuxent River as the Fighting Falcon 34th Fighter Squadron.
